▼ **Regional Activity:** A quake registering 4.4 was recorded a minute before midnight on Saturday along the western margin of the Cherry Range of east-central Nevada. No earthquake activity has been detected here or in the adjoining Butte Valley during the past 50 years of detailed earthquake monitoring. It is unlikely the quake was felt.

• Tectonic activity returned to the Holbrook Junction seismic zone with three quakes recorded in the 2.0 range. A 2.3 temblor happened along the southern portion of the Antelope Valley fault zone in the Walker River Canyon.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity was the lightest since early February. The largest quake measured 2.2 and occurred near Mt. Morrison.
