▼ **Regional Activity:** Three earthquakes in the 3.0 range were recorded, a 3.6 and 3.5 along the prominent Pahrump Valley fault zone near the California/Nevada border in Pahrump Valley, and a 3.1 about 8 miles south of Caliente in Meadow Valley.

▼ A north-northeast trend of 1.0s and 2.0s were recorded between Mammoth Lakes and Buena Vista Valley. The largest tremor registered 2.6 and occurred Sunday, July 21, east of Hawthorne in the Garfield Hills. Other notable regional events included a 2.0 east of Mono Lake, a 2.1 in Gabbs Valley Range, and a trio of 1.0 in Buena Vista Valley.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity remained in the 40-50 events/week level. Seven tremors measured in the 2.0 range with the largest registering 2.6.
