▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Beginning the afternoon of August 31, activity in the Long Valley caldera increased significantly. Twenty-four quakes, including three in the 2.0 range, were recorded during a brief two hour flurry two miles west of Casa Diablo Hot Springs. Minor activity was detected throughout the week south of the caldera near Mt. Morrison.

▼ **Regional Activity:** Five quakes were recorded in the Holbrook Junction seismic zone, including a pair of 2.0s and one as large as 3.3. A 2.3 temblor triggered a few miles north of Holbrook Junction along the western Pine Nut Range.

▼ A 3.1 quake occurred northwest of Bishop and a 3.6 quake in southwest Nevada near Lathrop Wells was followed by nine aftershocks.
