▼ **Regional Activity:** Most of the activity occurred during a brief swarm of 16 quakes 35 miles south of Mina, in northern Fish Lake Valley. The sequence began just after noon on Monday with a 2.4 temblor. Although most of the activity concluded Tuesday afternoon, a 3.0 complete the sequence on Thursday. Fish Lake Valley has recorded 13 events registering +3.0 since 1900, including one 5.4 event in 1982.

▼ The largest of eight tremors west of Bishop registered 2.2, a 2.3 event occurred in the Holbrook seismic zone, and a 1.0 quake was centered about a mile west of Virginia City.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity dropped to its lowest levels since the first week of February. The largest event measured 2.3 and occurred Thursday.
