▼ **Regional Activity:** Seismicity jumped to over 66 events/week with two vigorous sequences.
 ▼ An earthquake registering 4.0 on Tuesday morning was the largest event in an ongoing earthquake swarm south of Mina, in northern Fish Lake Valley. Activity first began here in early September and has included several 1.0s and 2.0s and one 3.0 on 9/12.
 ▼ A robust sequence of 23 events was detected northwest of Reno at Border Town. The activity included three quakes measuring 2.0 or stronger. It was centered near a 4.6 quake last November 15.
 ▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity increased to its highest levels since the first to weeks of August. Contributing to the activity were continuing pulses of movements in the Sierra near Mt. Morrison.
