▼ **Regional Activity:** Although seismicity was much reduced from last week, regional activity remained above the 20 events/week mark.

▼ A robust earthquake swarm was detected about 47 mi. northwest of Beatty, Southern Nevada, in the Nellis Air Force Range. Forty quakes were recorded, including 18 2.0s and four in the 3.0 range. The largest two events measured 3.9. The activity was centered on the just north Nevada Test Site boundary near Quartzize Mountain and occurred Oct. 17-19.

▼ The largest of nine events northeast of Reno at Border Town measured 2.7, a 2.8 was the strongest of four quakes in the Holbrook seismic zone, and a 3.1 was recorded west of Mammoth Lakes in the Sierra. Mammoth Lakes activity was about normal.
