▼ **Regional Activity:** Once again, regional earthquake activity topped the 30 events/week mark.
 ▼ Last week's robust earthquake swarm about 47 mi. northeast of Beatty in the Nellis Air Force Range continued into this week. The largest quake measured 3.1 and occurred October 24.
 ▼ Activity following last week's swarm northeast of Reno at Border Town reduced to a single 1.6 event. Four quakes in the 2.0 range occurred in the Holbrook seismic zone and a swarm of 21 tremors were recorded west of Bishop along the prominent Round Valley fault zone, at the foot of Red Mountain.
 ▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Reduced below normal background levels with 16-1.0s in the caldera and 12-1.0s along the Mt. Morrison Trend; no 2.0 activity.
