▼ **Regional Activity:** Regional earthquake activity remained about the same as the previous week. The largest earthquake measured 2.8 and occurred early Thursday morning SW of Mina in the Candelaria Hills. It was followed by four events later that morning, including one registering 2.5. A pair of 2.0s were also recorded 17 mi. to the SE in Fish Lake Valley.

▼ **Minor tectonic movements** continued at Border Town where the largest of three events measured 2.6. Activity has been on or off here ever since a 4.6 quake triggered on November 15, 1995.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** A cluster of 17 quakes, including a trio of 2.0s, triggered at Mammoth Mountain and the largest of four temblors in the 2.0 range near Mt. Morrison registered 2.5.
