▼ **Regional Activity:** Two quakes in the upper 4.0 range triggered along the California/Nevada border on Friday. The first quake occurred at 1:00 am and registered 4.7. The second quake happened at 9:40 pm and measured 4.9. Both quakes were centered about 4 miles northwest of Topaz Lake, near Holbrook Junction. There have been over 75 aftershocks analyzed thus far, including seven in the 2.0 range. Earlier reports suggested two other events in the 4.0 range following the 4.9 quake, however, this was later dismissed. Both quakes were widely felt in the region and as far away as Sacramento and Reno. The activity was centered in the southeastern-most portion of the aftershock zone from the September 12, 1994, Double Springs Flats 6.0 earthquake.

▼ A 1.6 quake occurred in the Bordertown aftershock zone, a 2.0 triggered south of Dayton, and a 2.0 was centered along the northwest shore of Pyramid Lake.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** 42 events were detected in the region, including seven in the 2.0 range.
