▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity was substantially reduced from last week's vigorous sequence of 239 events. Most of this week's activity occurred in the same location as the previous week - on the south side of HWY 395, about 2 miles southwest of the Mammoth Lakes airport. The largest events, however, triggered either north or south of this location. The largest of two a pair of 3.0s near Mt. Morrison measured 3.5, and a 3.0 tremor was detected a mile north of Casa Diablo Hot Springs.

▼ **Regional Activity:** The largest of three quakes west Holbrook Junction registered 3.0, a 2.3 was recorded north of Bridgeport Reservoir, and a 1.8 was centered near Bordertown. A temblor registering 2.8 was detected 35 miles east-southeast of Lovelock in Buena Vista Valley.
