▼ **Holbrook Junction/Topaz Lake region:** Activity continued to be rather robust for the second straight week. Minor seismicity was recorded through most of the week. But on Thursday, March, 8, a moderate 4.2 temblor struck the region. The quake was centered west of Holbrook Junction about a half mile inside the California border. Residents in Holbrook Junction and Topaz said it felt like a good jolt. It was felt as far away as Carson Valley and Lake Tahoe.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity increased substantially. The largest of 118 events registered 2.8 and occurred the evening of March 6 east of the airport, near Whitmore Hot Springs.

▼ **Regional Activity:** A temblor registering 3.0 was felt in Big Smoky Valley on Wednesday, March 6.
