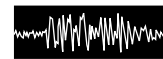

## Seismo-Watch

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Significant unrest continued for the second straight week. 41 earthquakes registered 2.0 or stronger, including five in the 3.0 range. Activity occurred within three principal areas: (Mammoth Mountain area, Casa Diablo Hot Springs, and Mammoth Lakes Airport), with some activity south of Convict Lake. The largest quake measured 3.4 and occurred Saturday in the Mammoth Mountain sequence. The region has been undergoing significant unrest since a vigorous swarm struck in mid February.

▼ **Regional Activity:** The largest of six quakes east of Holbrook Junction registered 2.9, a pair of quakes triggered east of Mono Lake, two 2.0s happened near Portola, and a 2.3 was detected in Dixie Valley.
