▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** Activity was winding down after a vigorous sequence of 239 events two weeks ago. Although 48 temblors were detected, only four registered 2.0 or stronger. The largest event measured 3.1 and occurred south of Convict Lake.

▼ **Holbrook Junction:** Robust activity returned to the area. A total of 25 events were recorded, including 11 registering 2.0 or greater. The largest quake measured 3.1 and occurred the morning of March 1.

▼ **Regional Activity:** two temblors measuring 3.1 and 2.1 were detected along the Clan Alpine Mountains in northern Dixie Valley, near Shoshone Creek; and a 2.3 quake occurred in the Excelsior Mountains east of Mono Lake.
