▼ **Regional Activity:** Once again, seismic activity was recorded northwest of Reno near Bordertown. The largest of seven quakes measured 3.0 and occurred Sunday night about 3 mi. west of Bordertown. Earthquake activity here has been on and off since a moderate 4.6 jolt on November 13, 1995.

▼ The largest of four quakes in the Antelope Valley aftershock zone measured 3.0, a cluster of four 1.0s triggered in the Holbrook seismic zone, and a 2.1 tremor was detected at Walker.

▼ A 3.2 was detected east Tonopah in Ralston Valley and a 3.0 was recorded east-northeast Lathrop Wells along the very active Rock Valley fault zone.

▼ **Mammoth Lakes Activity:** Earthquake activity continued to be below normal background levels.
