▼ **Mammoth Lakes Region:** A moderate earthquake registering M4.1 occurred at 10:13 a.m. Monday, Feb. 24, about 8 mi. southeast of Mammoth Lakes, near Mt. Morrison. It occurred in much the same location as a M4.2 temblor on Feb. 10. It was preceded by a trio of M3.0s earlier that morning, the largest of which measured M3.5. The main jolt was sharply felt at Mammoth Lakes. A number of tremors were also detected in the Lake Crowley area.

▼ **Regional Activity:** The Bordertown seismic zone jumped back into action with 13 events, including seven in the M2.0 range. A M1.9 temblor was recorded Tuesday, Feb. 23, under Carson City at a depth of 9 km. A M2.8 triggered in the Antelope Valley seismic zone and a M2.3 happened south of Hawthorne.
